
Why have a law firm library

- A firm library should
 - Meet the business goals of the firm
 - Enable researchers to do their best work
 - Organize the firms resources for most efficient retrieval
 - Make resources cost effective
 - Support the re-use of internally created knowledge
 - Collect the resources that best meet the needs of clients

What to collect

- Electronic vs. paper
- eBook vs. database
- Metered vs. contract
- Free vs. fee
- Internally created knowledge
